

Martha Rockwell has been employed as an intervention specialist, teaching preschool children with developmental delays for twenty-three years, the last 19 of those at Harold Lewis Center. She enjoys participating in many extracurricular activities for the benefit of the school. She initiated this public art project in the fall of 2010. That October, she happened to walk across the future sculpture site during preparations for the school's annual craft fair. Upon noticing the traffic flow surrounding her, she knew immediately that the otherwise unusable piece of land would be the perfect location for a sculpture that would celebrate the beautiful children of Union County and the inclusiveness of our community. With the support of the UCBDD board members and administration, as well as other community supporters, Martha has diligently worked to move this project forward.



"The Hopes and Dreams of Our Youth" sculpture grouping portrays the joy and youthful exuberance of life in Union County. The artist's conceptual framework for the sculpture is inspired by the myriad of educational, cultural, and athletic opportunities enjoyed by the citizens of Union County. All of these beloved rights and privileges are fully enjoyed within an environment of physical, intellectual, and religious freedom. The completed sculpture grouping will be a celebration of tolerance, understanding, and prosperity achieved through mutual cooperation. The youth of our community are the seeds of its future!
